The first line of each reference should be flush left with the margin of the page. Each subsequent line of your reference should be indented. Use the DOI. If a digital object identifier (DOI) is available, include it at the end of the reference. However, many current style manuals recommend italicizing book titles and magazine names (impossible to do on a typewriter) and using quotation marks around articles.
